Description:	Unison is a file-synchronization tool for Unix and Windows. It allows two replicas of a collection of files and directories to be stored on different hosts (or different disks on the same host), modified separately, and then brought up to date by propagating the changes in each replica to the other.
Installation Guide:	<p>Install Procedure :</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Download the file unison.sh.zip to Aspire one directly.2. Double click unison.sh.zip, and uncompress the zip file via "Xarchiver", there should be a new file named "unison.sh" in the same folder with unison.sh.zip.3. Go to unison.sh folder and double click unison.sh.4. Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the installation.
