Installation Guide:	<p>Install Procedure :</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Download the file <b>gimp.sh.zip</b> to Aspire one directly.</li><li>2. Double click <b>gimp.sh.zip</b>, and uncompress the zip file via "Xarchiver", there should be a new file named "<b>gimp.sh</b>" in the same folder with <b>gimp.sh.zip</b>.</li><li>3. Go to <b>gimp.sh</b> folder and double click <b>gimp.sh</b>.</li><li>4. Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the installation.</li></ol>
