- i. Issues Solved
 - 1. FIX: Resolution of auto switch is abnormal sometimes on Kirkini platform (nVidia GFX)
 - (a) Procedure:
 - 1) Plug in and pull out VGA connector repeatedly
 - 2) Resolution will be abnormal sometimes
 - (b) Solution:
 - 1) nVidia will change resolution automatically after doing auto switch
 - 2) If nVidia's restored resolution is not equal to the resolution we saved, ePresentation will restore to the saved resolution.

 - 1. FIX: Can't load ATI 64-bit library on Windows XP 64-bit version

 - 1) Run program
 - 2) Will pop up error message
 - (b) Solution:

 - 2. FIX: Can't auto switch on Garda3 platform (Intel UMA)
 - (a) Procedure:
 - 1) Plug in VGA connector
 - 2) ePresentation doesn't switch to clone mode.
 - (b) Solution:
 - 1) Add delay and check the connection status through Intel GFX API
 - ii. UI/Specification changes
 - 1. UI: Support Windows XP 64-bit version
 - iii. InstallShield
 - 1. Support both Windows XP 32-bit and 64-bit version installation
